

Terms of Use – Premises of Munich Maker Lab e.V.

The use of the premises is permitted to members of Munich Maker Lab e.V., who have signed these temporary terms of use, and therefore, have agreed to the following regulations.

Use

If you notice signs of illness such as cough, sore throat, shortness of breath or fever (or loss of sense of smell and taste), or have had contact with a proven corona case in the past 14 days, the stay in the premises of the Munich Maker Lab e.V. is not allowed!

Check-In & Check-Out

When entering and leaving the club rooms, the check-in/-out terminal with the member card must be used.

The card ID is saved in a log together with time stamps. Only in the event of a positive corona case of a member, this log is evaluated in order to notify all members who have been in the club rooms together with the sick person. In addition, the total number of members present is displayed in a suitable place on the Internet.

Hand disinfection when entering the club rooms

Before entering the club rooms, the hands must be disinfected with hand disinfection that you have brought with you.

1.5 m distance

During the stay in the club rooms of Munich Maker Lab e.V., people who do not belong to the same household must keep a distance of 1.5 m from each other.

Maximum number of people, work areas & guests

Only members are allowed to enter the club rooms! A maximum of 5 people may be in the club rooms at the same time. People from different households each work in their own area (workshop, community & kitchen, electronic corner, 3D printer & laser cube).

Obligation to cover your mouth and nose

In the club rooms there is an obligation to wear a mouth and nose cover.

Cleaning objects before and after use

Before and after using machines, tools, etc., they must be disinfected with the surface disinfection provided. To do this, apply the surface disinfection in sufficient quantity and leave it on for 30 seconds.

Working outside & regular ventilation

Work that's reasonable to be done outdoors, should be carried out in front of the club rooms, if possible. If the weather permits, keep the entrance doors or gate (whichever you can keep an eye on) open. If this is not possible, ventilation must be carried out once an hour.
